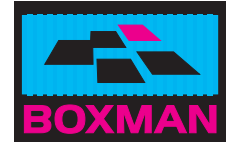


Featured container modification

Seresin Estate - Boxman Group completed this modification in March of 2005 at our Nelson depot.



Seresin Estate

The brief from the client was to provide comfortable semi-permanent accommodation for their office staff located at their vineyards in Marlborough.

Initially with architects involved the project did not look like it was going to be cost effective for Seresin, however with a good deal of consultation through the design process we were able to produce a high end office product for a very affordable \$58,000 price tag, delivered onsite.

The 2 x 45G1 new containers provided a floor space 54m².

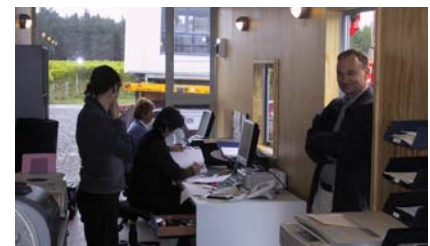
The design needed to allow for maximum natural light whilst maximising workspace, this involved utilising some interesting window configurations.

There was also a requirement for an "indoor/outdoor" smoke area in the front end of one of the containers. We were able to achieve this by fitting a set of French doors to

segregate this area and provide open air access via a front end cut out.

The units were fitted out with Pink Batts insulation on the walls and ceiling behind a smart looking varnished plywood interior lining.

All electrical, computer and communications wiring was hidden behind the ply lining.
