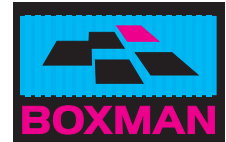


Tradeshow & display container modification

Boxman Group completed this modification in October of 2012 at our Nelson depot.



The New Zealand Merino Wool Company

The New Zealand Merino Wool Company approached Boxman with the idea of having a transportable all-in-one trade show display unit.

The outcome of the consultation process was an agreement for a 6.1m new container, with one entire side wall that would fold down to create additional floor space, and an externally fitted awning. The ultimate requirement was to provide an open walk-through space easily navigated by customers viewing the display.

Due to the premium nature of the NZ Merino Wool brand, the fit out of the container needed to be clean and customisable, but also allow for the functionality of the fold down retractable side wall. We have achieved this

outcome whilst being aware of the clients budget restraints.

There are a number of options for the internal lining of the container, in this case the client's choice was plywood. Subsequent projects have used painted MDF and Melamine boards.

The walls can be insulated if required.

Often the task of holding up or folding down container walls or parts thereof can be achieved using gas struts, however in this case as it was an entire side wall weighing some 350kg, Boxman chose to use 2 x 850kg rated robust winches.

In order to reduce the weight factor, the container sidewall was cut out and replaced

with Electro Galvanised flat panel steel.

The floor and lowered side wall of the container was clad in a Kwila decking making for a lovely finish, however any type of flooring product can be used.

The container has full electrical wiring to enable the operation of TV/Computer display screens and other appliances, as well as an assortment of nifty features making the operation of the container easy and flexible for the user.

Boxman can produce these trade show containers to suit individual customer requirements and budgets.
