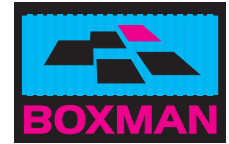

### About this container

The 6.1m (20ft) long 28.4m<sup>3</sup> is the most popular type of refrigerated container used in the domestic frozen/chilled storage market.

These containers operate at temperatures between -25°C and +20°C

They are generally sold in a food grade condition, as storage of food is their main purpose.

Pricing of used containers varies according to grade and market supply parameters.

### Boxman containers

The vast majority of Boxman used containers are still perfectly serviceable, they have simply been retired out of shipping through the natural renewal cycle that occurs in the shipping industry.

### Container features

Boxman refrigerated containers come with a standard T-section aluminium floor, a refrigeration system integrated into the front wall of the container, a high grade stainless steel interior wall finish and either a muffler grade stainless steel or aluminium sheet exterior wall construction.

Most have forklift pockets for ease of handling.

All containers undergo an electrical inspection prior to being delivered to customers for operational use.

Boxman can also provide a re-certification service so that used containers can be CSC Plated to allow for coastal and international shipping.

#### Non Operating Reefers (Insulated Only)

These containers can be sold in a non operational (NOR) status as an insulated container.

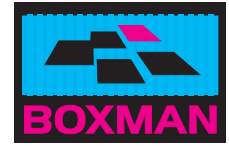
The primary reason for purchasing an insulated container is to store goods that are temperature sensitive, however do not require chilling or freezing.

Insulated containers can also provide some protection from the (usually minor) condensation issues associated with standard steel containers.

## Boxman's refrigerated container features



### 1. Aluminium 'T-Section' floor

These containers have a standard Aluminium 'T-Section' Floor.



### 2. Machinery/Refrigerant

Refrigerated containers come with a number of different machinery types, primarily Carrier, Thermo King and Daikin. Most systems use R134A or R404A refrigerant gas.



### 3. 3 phase power supply

Refrigerated containers require three phase power supply, either a Cee Form receptacle (left) or a standard PDL receptacle (right) is needed to attach the container plug into.
